RE: Child Born After Issuance of Visa to a Parent or During the Permanent Resident
Mother's Temporary Visit abroad

Pursuant to 9 FAM 201.2-3.3 Certain Alien Children Not Required to Obtain Visas.

The child born after the issuance of a visa to a parent, or a child under two years of age born of a Lawful Permanent Resident alien mother during a temporary visit abroad, is not required to have a visa if the child is:

- (1) Born subsequent to issuance of an immigrant visa to the accompanying parent within the validity of the parent's immigrant visa *and the child is entitled to derivative status*; or
- (2) Born during the permanent resident mother's temporary visit abroad provided *that*:
 - (a) Admission is within two years of birth; and
 - (b) Either accompanying parent is applying for readmission upon first return after the birth of the child.
